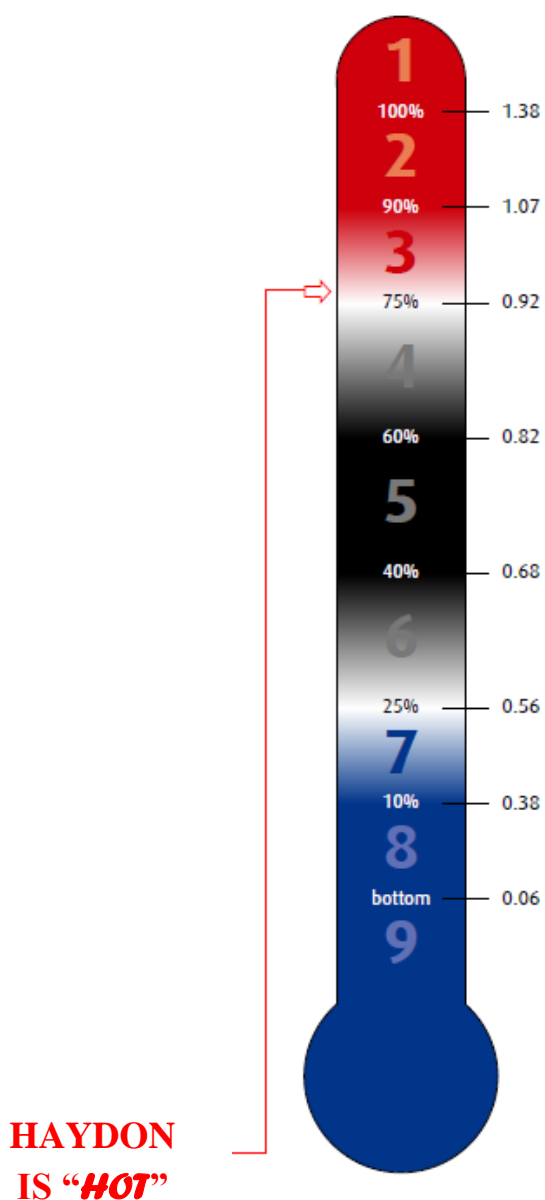

AS LEVEL 2010



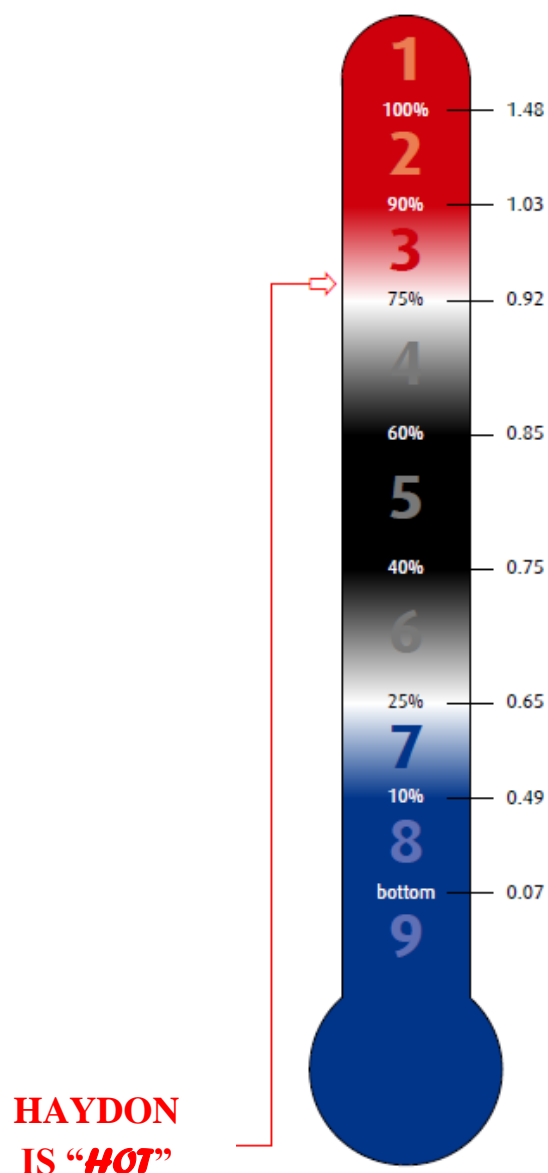
